

The London and South East Craft Brewing Festival

- 1/ The competition will take place on Saturday November 13th.
Judging will be from approx. 10.00 to 13.00.
- 2/ To enter your beer in advance complete the entry form and post with your remittance to Richard at Cheers Winemaking and Brewing. Any queries phone on 020 8644 0934.
However you can enter your beer on Friday evening (see below)
- 3/ Deliver Beers on Friday evening from 6.00 p.m. to 9.00 p.m. and in an emergency on Saturday from 9.00 a.m. to 10.00 a.m. (Friday please if possible)
Beers must be collected when the festival closes at 6.00 on Saturday or on Sunday from 10.00 am to 12.00 noon.
- 4/ Draught beer must be presented in bright condition as there is not enough time for the beer to settle. Phone if you need advice on presenting bright beer in good condition.
Barrels, kegs and Cornelius kegs are all suitable. CO2 gas is permitted but you can gravity dispense if you prefer. We will check the condition of the beers and add CO2 if necessary.
- 5/ Minimum amounts are 3 gallons for draught and 6 pint bottles for bottled beer.
Please try to bring more if you can as people will be thirsty.
- 6/ Beers should be to an established style i.e. bitter, stout, mild, porter, wheat etc.
The style should be labelled on the front of the beer to aid the judges who judge according to style. Barrels, kegs and bottles must be labelled on the reverse side with the brewer's name and phone number. Beer bottles should be reusable, pint or 500ml. and preferably brown,
But it is not important as the judges judge the beer not the bottles.
- 8/ Due to the friendly nature of the competition and the fact that we are using reliable and highly qualified judges, the competition is open to all including the people working at the festival.
